

Special Education

A Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) will be provided by our special education service providers and related services (direct and indirect) for all students (pre-k thru 12th grade) on Individualize Educational Programs (IEPs). Our special education personnel (included related services) will be actively engaged in planning to provide an equitable education, individualized services and equal access to the curriculum and instruction used during long distance learning. Our service providers will seek input from parents and include them in the decision making of how we will structure long distance learning. For our learners with sensory, i.e. blind/visually impaired, deaf/blind, or deaf/hard-of-hearing, physical or print disabilities access to the curriculum like videos and print material will be provided at the same time the rest of their peers have access to the curriculum. Other specialized instruction will be used to modify the curriculum to provide access to our learners with special needs according to their IEP.
